

MNA surveyed our 3000 members related to COVID-19 and workers compensation. Over 28% of those surveyed contracted COVID-19 over the past year and of those, over 92% did not file a workers compensation claim, majority citing they did not know it was an option. See direct quotes from Montana nurses about COVID-19 and workers compensation:

- "Didn't even know it was an option"
- "When I spoke with HR they told me I wouldn't receive it"
- "No idea about it"
- "I don't know where I got COVID from. Probably work, but can't prove it"
- "I did not know it was an eligible item"
- "Was unaware I could"
- "Did not know it was an option"
- "I was told not and it was a pandemic"
- "I was never told this was an option"
- "Did not this was an option"
- "Didn't know I could"
- I wasn't given the option and it was presumed I contracted it outside of work"
- "Not aware that it was available"
- "I did not know I could, I was told by Employee Health that I would have to use what was left of the 80 hours for COVID-19 then had to use my PTO, the my sick leave"
- "Didn't know we could"
- "I wasn't told I was able to make a claim"
- "Didn't know I could"
- "Work is the only high risk place I go. I eat and drink there but I couldn't prove I contracted it at work"
- "Was not told COVID qualified for WC"
- "Was not able to qualify for it"
- "Didn't realize it was an option"
- "My employer said that nobody ever contracted COVID-19 on the job"
- "I wasn't offered this option"
- "Wasn't aware I could and no one other than the Infectious Disease nurse asked me about it"
- "Told me it was not covered"
- "Employee health didn't tell me"
- "I didn't know that was an option!"
- "Was not instructed, did not know it was an option"
- "I was told I could not prove that I contracted COVID from work and that it couldn't be considered a work related exposure"
