Vice Chair Buttrey-Mr. Chair, I motion a do pass on House Bill #297 (standard opening motion)

And I wholehearted agree with Representative Gist that there a lot of front-line workers who have put themselves in the line of fire over the last year as they do every day in the healthcare industry, but I think it is a step in the right direction. And, I took a pledge that I would fully support my constituents who work in those capacities especially the nurses. This is just really to honor them. I think it is a step forward.

Seekins-Crowe: Mr. Chair, and thank you very much. While I do appreciate what emergency workers and folks in the hospital have done over the past year, ... I just find the language in this bill would eventually be a MT trial lawyers dream, and for that I will vote No.

Galloway: I have to come out in not support this for two facts. The fact is that It opens the door for what about all the rest of front-line workers, and then also the burden of any of these claims would be put upon all the other employers ...

The Chair asks for a roll call vote to move this bill out of committee and be heard on the House floor.
